To help you with this, work from the center out, keep your darker darkness (shades) no darker than a value of six or seven, and your lighter (light effect or all in light) a value of three or four. Use the hierarchy of value You can control the eye using the value It is safe to say that a successful image is one that reads quickly well and has the power to touch you emotionally. Using value or tone and assigning different areas of your coal design to less or more dark tones can be a very useful tool. In the image above, based on a photograph of Josiah Bice (open in a new tab), the darkest values are used on the subject. Note the lightest value on the cheek and the darkest value reserved for the mass of its body. Using a value hierarchy, you can direct the viewer to what you want them to see first. In this case, Steve smokes his pipe. Everything else becomes less important. It is the essence of the image. 04. SquintSquinting your eyes simplifies things Sometimes 20/20 vision is not useful. When we look at what we are drawing there is a ton of information that goes through the gate of the eye. And an image filled with unnecessary details, erases the effect of a piece. The goal is to change and simplify. Squinting our eyes just a little (or maybe removing your glasses) blushes the image values and help us see a simplified version of what we are looking at overall. Squinting also helps us see simple formsclearly. Nails those simple shapes helps with the overall essence of the piece. 05. Explore thick and thin lines not all lines are created equal using using and and thin lines is an interesting idea, and iteÁÁÁs funny how many artists miss this very helpful technique in their work. In a charcoal drawing, if every line has the same width or is drawn using the same exact pressure, it ends up looking like a colouring book drawing and can come across as very monotonous and boring. Using thick and thin lines in your drawing can make it so much livelier.So how do you use this technique, and what do you need to know? The rule of thumb is that lines on top of things are thinner since light is hitting them and lines underneath objects can be thicker since there are usually shadows sitting there. ThateÁÁAs it. Use an eraserSometimes light can be 'erased' out The cool thing about charcoal is that iteÁÁAs easy to control. You can move it around easily. Once you apply charcoal you can remove it or erase it where it's not needed. In the picture above, the erased part marks out where the light is hitting the model's head.You just might need a tool belt Traditional artists have plenty of tools of the trade to choose from, and the tools for creating charcoal drawings are particularly cool. The image above shows some great ones: a really small fine-line eraser (opens in new tab), a kneaded eraser (opens in new tab) that you can bend and squash, and a hardcore eraser pen (opens in new tab) for those tough, heavy lifting erasing jobs.Using charcoal or pastels requires us to 'move' or apply the medium, and there are many ways to accomplish this. Your finger is the most obvious, yet can be streaky or too small. A Webril Wipe (opens in new tab) is a great tool for making a large mass of charcoal in one stroke.08.
